Immediately leave the traffic circle at the first exit, toward 68 North (Gardner). Follow directions below***

From MA Route 2 East, take Exit 22 (Gardner Hubbardston), and enter the traffic circle.
Leave the traffic circle at the third exit, toward 68 North (Gardner). Follow directions below***

Follow the road as it curves around to the right.
Turn left, following 68 North.
Using the middle lane of this road, drive straight, through one stop light.
At the first Stop Sign (Fidelity Bank on your left), turn left onto City Hall Ave.
Park in the small parking lot on your right, immediately after Gardner Family Medicine.
Disregard signs for "Medical Office Parking Only."
The People's Place is further up the road, after the F.O.E. building.

TD: \$85.00 per dog
TDX: \$125.00 per dog
(includes AKC \$0.50 recording and \$3.00 service fees)

Certification (TD test only): A written statement must accompany each entry for any dog that has not previously passed an AKC TD or TDU test. This statement must be dated within two years of the date the test is to be held, signed by a provisional or approved tracking judge or evaluator, and must certify that the dog has satisfactorily performed a certification test. Following AKC guidelines, any tracking certification has an expiration date in 2020 or 2021 will be granted an additional one-year extension.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Combined Tests Exchange Policy: This will be a combined test. The exchange policy outlined in Section 17 of Chapter 1 of the Tracking Regulations will be in effect.

CLOSING DATE: Thursday, May 6, 2021, at the home of the Test Secretary. Entries cannot be accepted, canceled or substituted after the closing date and time except as specified herein.

A **drawing** to determine which entries will participate in the test will be held at 7:00 PM on Thursday, May 6, 2021 at the home of the test secretary. The drawing for the TD test will be random among all entries received except that preference shall be provided to untitled dogs. The drawing for the TDX test will be random among all entries received except that preference shall be provided to entrants that have not earned a TDX title. Both tests will have a Test Worker Option draw, in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 17d of the Tracking Regulations.

The Test Secretary shall notify all entries of the result of the draw by email or mail only. Calls may be made to the Test Secretary after the draw on Thursday, May 6, 2021 from 8:00-9:00pm.

WITHDRAWALS: In the event an accepted entry withdraws after the closing date, the entry fee will be refunded only if there is an alternate accepting entry into the test. There will be no refunds until 7 days after the test.

Bitches in season may participate provided that the Test Secretary and Judges are notified that a bitch is in season prior to the drawing for tracks. The last track laid shall be reserved for the bitch in season.

TROPHIES

A rosette with club colors and a paperweight with the club logo will be presented to all who pass.

THE RUTH RIDINGS MEMORIAL TROPHY A Crystal trophy in memory of TCM founding President Ruth Ridings will be presented to each German Shepherd dog that exhibits a passing performance.

THE JUNIOR EXHIBITOR TROPHY A silver picture frame will be presented by TCM to any registered AKC Junior Handler who handles an entry to a passing performance in this test.

Kathy Cleaver offers a \$20 award to any handler earning their first title at this test.

Matthew Winters offers a \$20 award to any Spaniel who exhibits a passing performance in this test.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
